Psalm 91 (New International Version)

Summary: This is a somber piece with a fighting spirit. It is a glimpse into the battle that rages for our souls and the promise of God's faithfulness.

Character Requirements: Minimum of four actors, no maximum. No gender requirements. Lines can be broken up differently depending on the number of actors you choose to work with.

Characters: Number 1 represents the one who is sheltered; 4 represents God; 2 & 3 change roles throughout the piece (i.e. neutral characters, demons, and angels).

Note: The blocking is just a suggestion and not a requirement. Feel free to change the blocking completely to suit your needs.

Begin with 1 standing downstage center facing downstage. 2, 3, and 4 are one level upstage of 1 and begin facing stage right.

1: Psalm 91. New International Version.

(Kneeling down) He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High (lower head after 'Most High')

- 2 4: will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. (1 puts hands up, 2, 4, and 3 cover 1 with their arms in a sweeping motion)
- 1: (Head up) I will say of the LORD,
- 2: He is my refuge (step downstage right)
- 3: and my fortress, (step downstage left)
- 2-4: my God, in whom I trust.

4:	Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare (4 helps 1 up and stage left as 2 and 3 become the "deadly pestilence") and from the deadly pestilence.
1:	He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge;
1 AND 4:	his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.
1:	You will not fear (walks center as 4 stays upstage left)
2:	the terror of night, (said with sinister voice)
1:	nor
3:	the arrow that flies by day, (2 and 3 release arrows)
1:	nor
2 AND 3:	the pestilence that stalks in the darkness (stalking towards 1), nor the plague that destroys at midday! (Arms raised with sword to strike 1)
4:	A thousand may fall at your side (sword thrown from the hands of 3), ten thousand at your right hand (sword thrown from the hands of 2), but it will not come near you (2 and 3 cower). You will only observe with your eyes and see the punishment of the wicked. (2 and 3 kneel, heads down, defeated)
	If you make the Most High your dwelling—
1:	even the LORD, who is my refuge-
1 AND 4:	then no harm will befall you, no disaster will come near your tent.
1:	For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways; (1 looks at 2 and 3, now the guardian angels, as 4 motions towards them)
2:	they will lift you up in their hands, (2 and 3 stay kneeling but palms and

	arms raise up, 1 walks downstage center, 4 walks upstage center)
3:	so that you will not strike your foot against a stone (2 and 3 stand keeping arms raised).
2:	(1 and 2 stamp right feet on 'tread') You will tread upon the lion and the cobra;
3:	(1, 2, and 3 stamp left feet on 'trample') you will trample the great lion and the serpent.
4:	Because he loves me (1 sinks to knees in prayer), I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name.

4 AND 2:	call upon me,
4:	and I will
4 AND 2:	answer him;
4:	I will
4 AND 3:	be with him in trouble,
4:	I will
4 AND 1:	deliver him and honor him.
1–4:	With long life will I satisfy him and show him my salvation. (2, 3, and 4 cover 1 again, striking a similar pose to the beginning)
